Meeting began at 7:10 PM with Norm Hankey, Member, Jack Bellinger, Member, Larry Davis III., Chairman and Scott McFarland, Agent present. The venue was changed to the residence of Mr. Bellinger who could not go to the Town Hall for the meeting due to a broken leg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Jack Bellinger mentioned a phone call from Robert Oleson who was looking for information concerning a project at the Southfield Congregational Church. Since he doesn't have any concrete plans there was not much the BOH could do until plans were filed with the Building Inspector.

McShane of 64 Canaan Valley Rd. has a special permit request to make a guest house a separate dwelling on a lot that is very large. A second well has been done. The Selectmen will review the request at their meeting.

Title 5 reports: At 450 Mill River-Southfield Rd. showed a small leaking tank which will be replaced. 80' of orange-burg is in good shape. Had a well point in the cellar but a new well has been done outside.

The Abelow houses at 282 Brewer Hill Rd. are being sold. The 2 septic systems are OK. The systems have garbage grinders in them but the Title 5's will state that the grinders may not be used.

Bob Tynan reports from the Southfield Store that all is working well as of the quarterly inspection in Dec. Scott along with Peter and Fred are to be present for the next inspection in March.

Pumping reports were reviewed.
