Septic plans submitted:

The plans for the septic shows a Tight Tank being installed in a proposed field drain designate. Scott will request a change to put the tank in another area beside the building. This is for possible future plans to expand the cottage from it's 2 bedroom design. The Tight Tank could be modified to be hooked up to a septic field. ①
