Monthly meeting June 9, 2015

The Board met at 7:15 PM with Scott MacFarland, Agent, Larry Davis, 111, Chairman, Jack Bellinger, Member, and Norman Hankey, Member present.

There was no meeting in May due to illness.

Septic plans for review: 260 Hadsell St, Katherine Slingluff. Owner plans to add an addition to the dwelling and needs a new septic system to service the increase in bedrooms from 2 to 4. Permit to construct was issued.

909 Norfolk Rd., Bruce Kafenbaum. Upgrade to system to connect the two houses on the property. Permit to construct was issued.

651 Hayes Hill Rd., Union Theological Seminary, Fefferman. There are three dwellings, Main house, a two bedroom house and a three bedroom house. Peter Scala was the original builder of the system. The current design is incomplete as to where the components of the system are located and some piping is "day lighted". Barry Finger of Wells Construction is the builder in charge.

Systems that were having back up problems were 279 Lumbert Cross Rd., Sally Turner, and John Johnston of 136 Hartsville Mill River Rd. Also Morrison of 95 Peter Menaker Rd. had back up problems and had the same work done to correct the situation. All problems were resolved by venting and other corrections.

Other issues: 229 Hartsville-New Marlborough Rd., the Sam Mills former restaurant.

The new owners want to run a "Tuesday Taco" served only on Tuesdays for 6 weeks. Scott will allow this permit temporarily. The owners are contemplating a full restaurant, but this will involve getting a public water permit from the DEP.

Camp WaWa Segowea. Scott is meeting with the principals about septic and water supplies.

Berkshire Springs needs another source of water and have bored a new well. Guides from the Water Association and the DEP must be followed.

There being no new business, the meeting adjourned at 8:15PM.
