Meeting was called to order at 9:05AM.

Lake Buel Restoration Preservation Hearing: Present for this continued hearing was Mr. Peter Hagen. Applicant submitted a NOI for the purpose of maintenance to the outlet of Lake Buel. A file number was finally received. The Commission reviewed DEP comments, which included that the Lake Buel Restoration Preservation contact the Army Corps of Engineers. Mr. Hagen stated that he was in contact with the Army Corps of Engineers and they do not have any issues with this project. After discussion a motion was made, seconded and so voted to close this hearing. A motion was made, seconded and so voted to approve this application per revised proposal narrative, DEP comments and special conditions.

The commission completed and signed a letter to the Board of Selectmen regarding establishing single stream recycling at the Transfer Station/Repair of existing concrete wall/pad. Per letter the commission received from the Board of Selectmen Administrative Assistant.
