

Conservation Commission – March 30, 2013

Members present were co-chairs Mr. John Weinstein & Mr. Ned Wilson.

Meeting was called to order at 10:12AM.

Minutes of February 23<sup>rd</sup> were approved as prepared.

Weldon Hearing: Present for this hearing was contractor Mr. Brian Jefferies. Applicant submitted a RDA for the purpose of a 12' x 16' barn will be replacing a 14' x 20' pole barn. Builder will be placing eight posts (postholes) to secure pole barn into ground. Property location is 15 Mill River Great Barrington Road. Commission reviewed the CMR and this project does not qualify for an exemption, it is 25 feet from the river so the commission is requiring applicant to file a NOI. A motion was made and so voted to close this hearing. A motion was made and so voted to accept this application has a positive #3.

Mr. Robert Beusman appeared before the commission in regards to installing a carport and other improvements for his property on Hadsell Street and gave a brief overview of what the project would be and stated the space now is currently lawn. The commission reviewed the 310 CMR 10.02 (a) (b) I. e which states that a RDA would need to be filed not a NOI.

Mr. Neil Blackwell appeared before the commission for a certificate of compliance for his property of 115 Clayton Mill River Road. Commission reviewed project (driveway & site work) with Mr. Blackwell and after the review signed the certificate of compliance.

Ms. Gail Ceresia of Berkshire Wetlands appeared before the commission for a certificate of compliance for Jay Levine of 164 Peter Menaker Road. Commission reviewed project (removal of trees & shrubs) with Ms. Ceresia and after the review signed the certificate of compliance.

The commission reviewed the mail:

- a. Notice of Decision – Special Permit – Spring Line Design for property owner McShane of Canaan Valley.
- b. MACC spring/summer workshops & trainings.
- c. Division of Fisheries & Wildlife – Bio map #2.

No other business was brought before the commission, so voted to adjourn at 11:02 AM.
