The Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles (RMV) would like to inform you that customers aged 65 and older, and customers with disabilities, can schedule an appointment at (most) <u>Service Center locations</u> during any available time **Monday** through Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

- An appointment is required for <u>Driver's License related transactions</u>.
- An appointment is required for ID related transactions.
- An appointment is *not* required for <u>Registration-related transactions</u>.

How to make an Appointment

Customers aged 65 and older and customers with disabilities can ask for assistance with an appointment by sending an email to:

- Customers can expect to receive a response from the RMV within 48 hours.

### Friendly Reminder

Massachusetts law requires customers age 75 and older to <u>renew their driver's</u>
 license in person.
