

Board of Health
Town of New Marlborough
Meeting Minutes for May 11, 2021

Meeting was called to order by conference call at 6:02 PM with Board members Larry Davis III, Jordan Chretien, Jack Bellinger and agent Scott McFarland present.

The April 13, 2021 Meeting minutes were reviewed and approved as submitted.

Covid-19 related updates: The hold on the Johnson & Johnson vaccine was lifted and it is back in use. The collaborative running the three county vaccination sites are now open for walkins during the announced clinic hours. There is also more vaccine availability through smaller local medical practitioners. Infection numbers and fatalities are dropping both in-state and nationally. Coronavirus guidance from the state continues to shift as re-opening continues. Town meeting is also coming up in the end of May and is will be run under the same guidelines as last year; masks will be required. The New Marlborough Memorial Day celebration was discussed and Scott will followup with the coordinator, Dave Hastings, to review current specific public gatherings guidance.

Housing inspection status for 1574 Hartsville-New Marlborough Rd updated, as last several correction items are to be completed by final inspection date on May 21, 2021.

Special permit for the Old Inn On the Green to allow for temporary/removable outdoor decking for the outdoor dining tent is clear of their septic infrastructure and Scott communicated to the Selectboard that the BOH had no concerns with the permit.

Scott received work from the camp director for Wa Wa Segowea that they will be opening this summer with several weeks of overnight camp and then several weeks of Family camp. Opening is in July.

Scott to followup with Johah Harshbarger regarding septic inspection or upgrade for 30 Mill River-Gt Barrington Rd.

Septic designs submitted for approval include:

The following perc tests were completed:

- 886 Sisson Hill Rd, (New construction, 4-Bedroom)
- Hartsville-New Marlborough Rd Map 407 Lot 3, (New Construction)

The Following Title 5 inspections were completed:

- 77 Clayton-Mill River Rd (Pass, add filter and outlet riser)
- 118 Corser Hill Rd (Pass, dist. Box replaced)
- 241 Adsit-Crosby Rd (Pass w/ repair: replace dist. Box, add effluent tee & filter)
- 393 Knight Rd (Pass)
- 99 Downs Rd (will Pass, needs water sample and install completion items)

The following well permits were issued:

- 1100 Clayton-Mill River Rd, additional well for irrigation and pool to replace surface water source.
- 915 Norfolk Rd, well for new construction

New Bd of Health permit fees were discussed briefly and Scott plans to bring them to the next meeting.

Motion to adjourn was seconded. Meeting adjourned at 6:42 PM. Next meeting is scheduled for June 8, 2021.
