January 22, 2018

The minutes were accepted.

The January film series was cancelled due to bad weather. The same film will be shown on February 6 at 7 pm.

Problems have arisen with the transportation for the school's visits. There have been bus problems. The children have little time to learn about the library and no time for a story. Debbie will speak to the school. Perhaps a personal appeal to the Massini Bus Company may help.

Moran Mechanical is no longer servicing oil burners. Debbie will call Lipton Oil to see if they will service the library oil burner.

Town Manager Mari Enoch told Debbie that the library structural needs have been considered by the Town. Debbie does not see other serious needs at this time.

There may be a February vacation program.

Jane Burke has received a cultural council grant to hold Science Saturdays on the first Saturday of each month beginning February 3 from 10-12 at the library for 5 months. The program is suitable for children aged 6-12 years. She has also suggested some science related books that Debbie can order for the library. Nanci Worthington has approached the library to offer Citizen Science, a program of observation skills. We suggested that she partner with the Land Trust. No date has been set.

We received the Goodness Trust check, \$1479.76.

Debbie will order new glass tops for the adult library room tables from Sheldon.

The next meeting will be held February 12 at 8:30 a.m.
