The transfer of account to New Marlborough Friends of the Library is underway at Berkshire Bank. The library has received an additional bequest of \$20,571.06 from the Priddle Estate. This will be deposited into the Priddle Trust Account.

The Pie Sale raised \$500.

Blume Electric submitted a new bid for the generator-\$26,001. Ormsbee's Garage will charge \$2528.30 for the gas hook up.

The library will have to file a Special Permit application for the generator installation. There will be a cost of \$200 for the permit.

Debbie has submitted the Action Plan Update to the Library Commissioners.

The Revolutionary War Monument is in the process of being erected on the library lawn.

The homework center program has not begun.

The school trips are going well.

The Cookbook Club will meet in December.

Over 100 people attended the Halloween Party.
