The Pfizer Omicron-specific COVID-19 vaccine booster will also likely be available, pending CDC approval and state vaccine distribution. Both shots can be given on the same day.

Walk-ups will also be welcome as time and supplies allow. Everyone should bring their health insurance card, COVID-19 vaccine card, and a mask to the clinic.

In addition, <u>a limited number of in-home vaccinations</u> will be provided on <u>Tues. Sept. 27</u>, <u>1-3 pm</u> for New Marlborough residents who are unable to access either flu clinic site.
