## Notice to New Marlborough Taxpayers

On Monday, April 13, 2020, the New Marlborough Board of Selectmen voted the following provisions as allowed by Sections 10 and 11 of Chapter 53 of the Acts of 2020 recently signed by Governor Charles Baker:

1) The due date for all FY 2020 fourth quarter **Real Estate and Personal Property** taxes has been extended from May 1<sup>st</sup> to June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Payments received in the Tax Collector's office on or before June 1<sup>st</sup> will be considered on time. Payments received after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be subject to interest and late fees.

2) Fees and interest on any **Motor Vehicle** excise tax bill that was due on or after March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 will be waived if the tax is paid on or before June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020. No fees or interest will be waived on any bills that had an initial due date prior to March 10<sup>th</sup> or is paid on or after June 30<sup>th</sup>.

These provisions are available to Towns as part of the Commonwealth's response to the COVID19 pandemic and are tied to the current state of emergency.

## Making Payments

Due to COVID19 the town offices are closed. Payments can be made in the drop box located outside the townhall, online at www.newmarlborough ma.gov or mailed to PO Box 220 Mill River MA 01244.
