Question 1: Shall the Town of New Marlborough be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2 ½, so called, the amounts required to pay the bond issued for Capital Road Projects?

The polls open at seven (7) AM and will remain open continuously until Eight (8) PM in the evening of said day when they will then be closed.


The Town will furnish all ballots and the election will be conducted according to the Australian System as enacted by the General Court and in conformity with the Election Laws of the Commonwealth.


