

The Berkshire Regional Planning Commission has begun to update the region's long-range Regional Transportation Plan (RTP). The Plan serves as the County's overarching transportation planning document and is required for our region to remain eligible to receive federal transportation funding. The plan is updated every four years.

To help identify transportation needs, BRPC has developed a public survey – available online at www.surveymonkey.com/r/berkshireplan. The survey is meant to provide Berkshire residents the opportunity to identify key transportation challenges and to voice in what way the County's transportation system can better serve them.
