LICENSE YOUR DOG TODAY AND AVOID ANY LATE FINES

****All dogs that have attained the age of six months or older shall be licensed annually (due April 1st of each year). The fee for a male or female dog is \$15.00; a neutered or spayed dog is \$7.00. Fee must be paid with application. Please make check payable to Town of New Marlborough. All dogs licensed after May 1st are subject to an additional \$25.00 late licensing fee.

A Copy of the Rabies Certificate and if applicable, proof that dog has been altered, must be enclosed before a license may be issued. (Unless, we already have the information on file) PLEASE USE THE BACK SHEET FOR ADDITIONAL DOGS!

Upon receipt of check and rabies certificate, the dog license will be returned to you. BE SURE TO ENCLOSE A SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE

SAVE THIS BOTTOM SECTION FOR YOUR RECORDS

Please note:

- 1. Penalties for violations of leash law is \$25.00
- 2. All dogs that have attained the age of six months or older must be vaccinated. A copy of the Rabies certificate must be enclosed.
- 3. If applicable, copy of proof that dog has been altered must be presented with application.
- 4. After May 1st a late fee of \$25.00 is added to the license fee; and after July 1st, a non-criminal citation will be issued adding another \$25.00 charge onto the previous charges.

THE MAIN REASON FOR LICENSING DOGS IS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY REASONS...WE MUST BE SURE THAT ALL DOGS ARE UP-TO-DATE WITH THEIR RABIES SHOTS.
